

## **Plantation Field Horse Trials 2018 Thoroughbred Competition Series**

Plantation Field Equestrian Events, Inc (PFEE) is excited to announce that we will continue having a thoroughbred recognition series during the 2018 Competition year. The series has been modified for 2018 giving more horses a chance to win.

This year the format will award \$100 to the Thoroughbred with the lowest overall score at each level, Beginner Novice, Novice, and Training, at each event. These prizes will be awarded at all three recognized horse trials: April 21-22, May 12, and June 9, as well as at all three starter horse trials: May 13, June 10, and November 3. Competitors still need to declare eligibility by submitting the declaration form by noon on Friday before the event. The owners of the winning horses will receive the prize money. Riders on horses in the series will be wearing an orange pinnie number.

All thoroughbreds with a jockey club registration, a tattoo, or an affidavit certifying his parentage from the breeder will be allowed. Horses will be allowed to compete in only one Plantation competition during a weekend. Additional considerations may apply.

We hope that not only competitors but breeders will recognize opportunities for thoroughbreds as an alternative to racing and as a second career after the horses' racing careers are over. Competitors in recent years have been importing horses at a record level for eventing and we feel that the thoroughbred is ideally suited for this sport. We hope this series will grow in future years.
